

NOTICE TO BIDDERS

SUPPLY OF SCHWING PUMP PARTS

The Stony Brook Regional Sewerage Authority, Princeton, New Jersey (the “Authority”), is requesting sealed bids for the **Supply of Schwing Pump Parts**.

The contract will run from November 1, 2022 through October 31, 2023, for a one-year contract.

Sealed bids will be received at the Authority's office at 290 River Road, Princeton, New Jersey, until **11:00 a.m.** prevailing time, on **Thursday October 6, 2022**, at which place, and time sealed bids will be publicly opened and read aloud. Bids which are mailed to the Authority's office shall be sealed and will not be opened until the time and place specified above. Bids that are received after the time and date specified above shall not be accepted or considered.

A Certified, Treasurers or Cashier's Check or bid bond in the sum of 10% of the bid, but in no case in excess of \$20,000.00 must be submitted with the sealed bid proposal along with the Non-Collusion Affidavit, Statement of Ownership Disclosure, Affirmative Action and Exhibit A Questionnaires, and Business Registration Certificate.

Bidders are required to comply with the requirements of N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 et seq. (P.L. 1975, C. 127) and N.J.A.C. 17:27.

The Authority will evaluate bids and any award will be made to the lowest, responsive, responsible bidder in accordance with and as defined in N.J.S.A. 40A:11-4. The Authority reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive minor informalities or irregularities in bids received in accordance with the law.
