Sealed Bids for Stony Brook Regional Sewerage Authority, River Road WWTP UV Disinfection and Effluent Filtration Project, Contract 19-2 will be received at the office of the Stony Brook Regional Sewerage Authority, 290 River Road, Princeton, New Jersey 08540 until 2:00 p.m. prevailing time, October 29, 2020 at which place and time said Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud.

The work includes new UV disinfection facilities; new effluent filtration facilities, construction of new UV Disinfection Building, construction of new Disc Filter Building, demolition of existing structures and equipment, installation of new backwash return pumps, installation of Nitrification Settling Tank effluent launder covers, installation of tank covers, and related structures, civil/site, mechanical, electrical and instrumentation/control work; and all appurtenant work required as shown and specified in the bid documents. The estimated construction cost is \$17 million and the time for completion is 600 consecutive calendar days.

There will be a site visit to the River Road Wastewater Treatment Plant, on October 14, 2020 at 9:30 a.m. All bidders will meet at the River Road Wastewater Treatment Plant located at 290 River Road, Princeton, New Jersey. It is recommended that all interested bidders attend. All attendees of the site visit must comply with the COVID-19 New Jersey Statewide mitigation strategies (Executive Order 107) including social distancing and the use of a full face mask to cover the nose and mouth.

Certified, Treasurer's or Cashier's Check or bid bond in the sum of 10 percent of the bid, but in no case in excess of \$20,000, Agreement of Surety, Surety Disclosure Statement and Certification (if bid amount is greater than or equal to \$800,000), List of Subcontractors, Ownership Disclosure, Bidder's Affidavit, Non-Collusion Affidavit, References, Acknowledgement of Receipt of Changes, Bidders Check List, and Questionnaire are required with each Bid.

Bidders shall not remove and submit the Bid pages separate from the volume of Contract Documents, but shall submit their Bid bound with the complete volume of attached Contract Documents, including all pages correctly assembled and all Addenda attached.

Contract Documents may be examined and obtained at the office of the Stony Brook Regional Sewerage Authority, 290 River Road, Princeton, New Jersey 08540. A non-refundable payment of \$300 by check made payable to the Stony Brook Regional Sewerage Authority will be required on each set of Contract Documents taken.

Successful bidder must furnish 100 percent Performance Bond and 100 percent Labor and Materials Bond.

This project is funded in part by the New Jersey Environmental Infrastructure Financing Programs and the successful bidder must comply with the provisions of N.J.A.C. 7:22-9 et seq. for the participation of

small business enterprises owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged (SED) individuals. A goal of ten (10) percent for SED participation has been set for this project. The invitation to bid is on an unrestricted basis whereby the successful bidder must fulfill the SED utilization requirements.

This contract or subcontract will be funded in part with funds from the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection and the New Jersey Environmental Infrastructure Trust. Neither the State of New Jersey, the New Jersey Environmental Infrastructure Trust nor any of their departments, agencies or employees is, or will be, a party to this contract or subcontract or any lower tier contract or subcontract. This contract or subcontract is subject to the provisions of N.J.A.C. 7:22-3,4,5, 9 and 10.

In accordance with the provisions of N.J.S.A. 58:11B-26, N.J.A.C. 7:22-3.17(a)24 and 4.17(a)24, the contractor (subcontractor) shall comply with all of the provisions of N.J.A.C. 7:22-9.

Bidders are required to comply with the requirements of N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 et seq. and, N.J.A.C. 17:27.

The Owner reserves the right to reject all Bids pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-13.2 and N.J.A.C. 7:22-9.10(a).
